Just thought i would add that Freemobicall is a South African innovation and your only cost is US\$ 4 for the cost of the licence. The other one is the text service Mobisms but that is not free. I buy Euro 5.60 or 336 pesos and that gives me 200 texts to the Philippines, not bad at 1.6 pesos a text for international, before it was costing me 20 pesos a text(converted from my currency)Thanks Applebite for the confirmation :) :)
